



Project Description

Becher Hoppe was contracted by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), Bureau of Project Development Local Program, to provide construction services, including project observation and administration, for the Springbrook Bridge on Monarch Road in the Town of Rolling. Coordination with adjacent residents for driveway access and the Town of Rolling and Langlade County Highway Department was a crucial element of this project as well as weekly updates to the WisDOT and Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
