



Project Description

Becher Hoppe worked with the Cable Union Airport Commission and the Wisconsin Bureau of Aeronautics to construct a partial parallel taxiway and new hangar development area. The project consisted of wetland delineation, wetland protection, clearing and grubbing, grading, construction of a partial-length parallel taxiway for Runway 17/35, storm water infiltration basins, and a development area for the future construction of privately owned hangars.
