



Project Description

The Cable Union Airport Commission partnered with Becher Hoppe and the Wisconsin Bureau of Aeronautics to review the airport conditions and to refurbish the pavement of the Airport's main runway, Runway 16-34. Weathering over many years had deteriorated the asphalt pavement, causing the need for resurfacing. Long-term master planning is underway for this airport with services provided by Becher Hoppe.
