



Project Description

CTH J in Oneida County serves local residents, commuters, commercial traffic, seasonal residents, and recreational visitors. Becher Hoppe worked with the local communities, Oneida County, and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to provide safety improvements to this sought-out local route while preserving the scenic values of this northwoods highway. The project goal was to recondition the surface of the highway, extend the width of the highway to accommodate a bike lane along the entire corridor, install snowmobile crossings, and minimize impacts to the surrounding forests, marshes, rivers, and lakes. Becher Hoppe was able to balance the public's interests with responsible highway design.

Project Features

- 10.6 mile project length from STH 47 to STH 70
- Reduced speed limit from 55 mph to 45 mph
- Minimal impact to adjacent land and resources
- Bike and snowmobile accommodations
